

Ordering The Presentations

Now is the time to order your *Walk Through* presentations! Our calendars for last year filled quickly, so you need to act promptly!

TWO WAYS TO SAVE

- ◆ Select a date prior to January 1, 2009 and receive **special fall prices**
- ◆ Enclose a check for full payment **at time of Reservation** and deduct **5%** from total order!

(Checks must be received **by July 31, 2008** for this discount to apply. When ordering **after July**, checks must be received within **seven days** of when your reservation form was received by fax or mail to be eligible.)

FEES
