



Ordering “Walk Through” Presentations

- ◆ Complete both sides of the form and sign the back. Include your 1st and 2nd choice dates.
- ◆ **Act fast for the best dates! April 15th is the first day of reservations.** Dates are assigned based on a first come, first served basis. Spring dates are especially popular and are quickly filled.
- ◆ Check your requested dates against your school’s master calendar. Our calendars fill quickly and similar dates may not be available if you need to change your date.
- ◆ **Orders from April 15 - May 15th:** You will be notified within 3 days if the dates you requested are not available. If your dates are available, a confirmation email will be sent within 2 weeks.
- ◆ **Ordering after May 15th?** Please contact the office for available dates.
- ◆ You may cancel or change dates up to **60 days prior** to scheduled presentations. **If cancellations or changes are made less than 60 days prior to scheduled presentations, you will be responsible for the full amount of invoice along with any other applicable charges.**
- ◆ Please note that our offices will be closed the month of July and reopen the month of August.
